## MAGICAL MINDS DANCE ARTISTS

Magical Minds is a children's dance theatre production for Primary Schools, focusing on positive mental health and well-being. Funded by (NCEL) CAMHS Provider Collaborative, Truefitt Collective is taking Magical Minds back on tour for 5-weeks across North London. Truefitt Collective are looking to recruit dance artists with strong performance and dance teaching experience on a freelance contract. Magical Minds uses dance, creativity and mindfulness to inform and educate children about positive mental health and provide early intervention support through follow on weekly workshops to targeted groups of children.

### Responsibilities:

- Attend 3x days of rehearsals / training to learn the Magical Minds production & workshop content
- Be available for all 5-school tour dates
- Undertake training in Dancing Mindfulness for Primary Schools
- Perform the Magical Minds production at each school
- Facilitate Dancing Mindfulness workshops at each school
- Support the Artistic Director throughout the school's tour
- Participate in Q&A's for children and teaching staff, engaging with them as a professional artist
- Opportunity to take on Artist in Residency in Primary Schools from November 26 - February 27, delivering weekly Mindfulness and Movement workshops and training
- Be able to travel to rehearsals and schools across North London
